MCSIG PLANS H1N1 VACCINE CLINICS

We are making plans to hold H1N1 vaccine clinics beginning as soon as we obtain the vaccine (likely mid to late November). We will administer the vaccine according to national recommendations for use of the H1N1 vaccine. Initial groups recommended to receive the H1N1 vaccine include pregnant women and adults with underlying chronic medical conditions. We plan to expand our H1N1 clinics and administer the H1N1 vaccine to other eligible groups as the national recommendations expand.
